The Steele County Board of Commissioners met in Emergency Session at 4:45 p.m. on June 18, 2010 at the Blooming Prairie City Hall. Commissioners Johnson, Schultz, and Shea were present.

Commissioner Johnson offered the following Resolution, seconded by Commissioner Schultz:

WHEREAS, the County of Steele, Minnesota, has sustained severe losses of a major proportion, brought on by tornadoes on the date of June 17, 2010;

WHEREAS, Steele County is a public entity within the State of Minnesota;

WHEREAS, the following conditions exist in Steele County as a result of the disaster:
extensive property damage, infrastructure damage and crop loss.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Board of Steele County, declares that a state of emergency exists within Steele County, with all the powers and responsibilities attending thereto as provided by Chapter 12, Minnesota Statute.

Upon the vote being taken, three Commissioners voted in favor thereof, Commissioner Kubicek and Ebeling absent and not voting. A copy of the Resolution is on file in the Auditor’s office.

Motion by Commissioner Schultz, seconded by Commissioner Johnson to adjourn. Ayes all.
