Motion by Commissioner Schultz, seconded by Commissioner Kubicek to approve the following ditch liens: JD 1-3% for 1 year; JD 2 – 4% for 1 year + interest; JD 5 – 6% for 1 year; JD 10 – 14% for 1 year + interest; JD 12 – 10% for 1 year + interest; JD 23 – 6% for 1 year; JD 24 – 2.5% for 1 year + interest; CD 1, Church Branch – 20% for 1 year + interest; CD 2 – 3% for 1 year + interest; CD 21 – 20% for 1 year + interest; CD 22 – 10% for 1 year; CD 23 – 20% for 1 year + interest; CD 24 – 5% for 1 year; CD 25 – 18% for 1 year + interest; CD 27 – 20% for 1 year; PTD 8 – 20% for 1 year; and PTD 9 – 18% for 1 year + interest. Motion by Commissioner Kubicek, seconded by Commissioner Schultz to approve the advance partial payment of the 2nd ½ tax settlement for Berlin Township in the amount of \$14,000. Ayes all.
