Resolution Declaring a State of Emergency

WHEREAS the blizzard conditions and heavy snowfall event on April 10, 2019 impacted the population of Steele County and its cities; and

WHEREAS the blizzard conditions and heavy snowfall event has caused a significant impact on public safety and travel; and

WHEREAS the Steele County Department of Emergency Management requests the Steele County Board of Commissioners to declare Steele County in a STATE OF EMERGENCY for the blizzard conditions and heavy snowfall event on April 10, 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Steele County Board of Commissioners declare Steele County in a State of Emergency for conditions resulting from the blizzard conditions and heavy snowfall event of April 10, 2019

This resolution shall become effective upon its passage and without further publication.

Adopted by the Steele County Board of Commissioners this 15th day of April, 2019.
