The Steele County Board of Commissioners held a Work Session at 3:00 p.m. on May 7, 2020, with Commissioners Glynn, Brady, Gnemi, Abbe and Krueger present. Also present were County Attorney Dan McIntosh, County Treasurer Cathy Piepho, County Engineer Greg Ilkka, County Administrator Scott Golberg and County Auditor Laura Ihrke.

Call to order and Pledge of Allegiance

Motion by Commissioner Gnemi, seconded by Commissioner Krueger to approve the agenda. Ayes all.

The Board discussed the request from South Central Human Relations Center for the purchase of 120' to the West of their site to allow for building expansion to their facility. The Board would need to issue and RFP per statute.

The Board then reviewed the communication from the Steele County Fair Board outlining future concerns related to the COVID-19 situation.

Discussion was held regarding the replacement of a Vacuum Truck for the Landfill. There was an unexpected breakdown of the existing vacuum truck. The Board reviewed quotes received from vendors.

County Administrator Scott Golberg gave a recap of the past seven weeks during the State of Emergency and talked about where we are at currently. Cathy then provided information on the estimated Covid-19 Financial Impact to the County that included property tax shortage scenarios and options for mitigation such as spending freezes on budgeted items, personnel actions (i.e. not filling vacant positions, furloughs), and capital project suspensions.

Commissioner Krueger presented a correspondence he would like to pass on to employees.
