The Steele County Board of Commissioners met in Special Session at 5:00 p.m. on February 9, 2021 with Commissioners Brady, Gnemi, Glynn, Krueger, and Abbe present. Also present were County Attorney Dan McIntosh, County Sheriff Lon Thiele, County Jail Administrator Anthony Buttera, IT Director Dave Purscell, Planning & Zoning Director Dale Oolman, County Administrator Scott Golberg and County Auditor Laura Ihrke.

Call to order and Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Commissioner Glynn, seconded by Commissioner Gnemi to approve the agenda with the addition of the SEMCAC presentation.

RESOLUTION

Resolution designating a depository for the County of Steele and persons authorized to sign orders thereon.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Steele County Minnesota, that "UBS Financial Services, LLC.," be and hereby is designated as depository for deposits and safekeeping of said County for such amounts as may be deposited herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that orders of the County of Steele drawn on said UBS Financial Services, LLC for funds to be transferred to another Steele County Depository in whatever form shall be signed by one if the following officer is Catherine Piepho, Treasurer of Steele County; and by two if signed by Laura Ihrke, Steele County Auditor, and Madison Hadoff, Steele County Financial Specialist.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that orders to purchase, sell, receive, or transfer investment securities on behalf of Steele County shall be initiated by Catherine Piepho, Steele County Treasurer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all transfers of funds or investment securities to and from any Steele County accounts on behalf of Steele County as directed to UBS Financial Services LLC may only be made to another depository or account of Steele County in the name of Steele County.

- E. Approve the revised Electronically Transfer Funds Resolution updating authorizations to include Madison Hadoff

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Steele County will electronically transfer funds and establish appropriate internal controls to ensure compliance with Minnesota law. Therefore, electronic fund transfers will be made for the following types of transactions: claim for payment from an imprest payroll bank account or investment of excess money; payment of tax or aid anticipation certificates; payment of contributions to a pension or retirement fund; vendor payments; and payment of bond principal, bond interest, and a fiscal agent service charge from the debt redemption fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, electronic funds transfers can be initiated by the following individuals: Catherine Piepho, County Treasurer/Finance Director; Laura Ihrke, County Auditor; Madison Hadoff, Financial Specialist; Kortney Miller, Payroll Specialist; Nancy Gritz, Deputy Auditor; and Karen Winter, Deputy Auditor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Treasurer/Finance Director shall establish internal controls to ensure compliance with Minn. Stat. §471.38, subd. 3 &

3a, to include without limitation, annually providing a certified copy of the delegation of authority to the disbursing bank(s), certifying to the Banks of Steele County the names and signatures of the persons named above and such certifying officer from time to time, hereafter, upon a change in the facts so certified, and immediately certifying to the Banks the names and signatures of the persons then authorized to sign or to act.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, a listing of electronic funds transfers transactions will be submitted to the Board at every Board meeting.

A transfer of funds by wire or electronic funds transfer in any of the Banks used by Steele County shall be by the signatures of the following officers or their alternatives;
