

Four Seasons Centre COVID 19 Guidelines:

Employees:

1. Employees are to maintain a 6 feet distance from patrons and co-workers.
2. Facemasks must be worn at all times.
3. Employees are to stay home if they feel sick or show signs of COVID-19 symptoms.
4. Employees must wear gloves while cleaning. Employees are to wash their hands with soap and water regularly.
5. Employees will take the MDH screening daily.
6. All Four Seasons Centre employees will be trained in cleaning for COVID-19.

Four Seasons Centre Ice Users:

1. Stay home if you feel sick or show COVID-19 symptoms.
2. Limit touching surfaces in the facility.
3. Maintain 6 feet of social distancing.
4. Limit personal items brought into the facility. Only bring what is absolutely needed.
5. Facemasks must be worn at all times.

Rink Procedures Hockey / Figure Skating Phase 3:

1. Each user group must have a COVID-19 liaison. This person should stay up to date on community and state recommendations and work with facility management to make sure these guidelines are followed by their organization.
2. The user group should submit a practice schedule/plan to the facility manager for review. This is to ensure social distancing can be maintained.
3. Skaters should enter new lobby entrance and exit SW double doors in East Arena.
4. Skaters should arrive to the Four Seasons Centre no more than 15 minutes before their assigned ice time.
5. Skaters will not enter the building until 15 minutes before the scheduled practice.
6. Skaters should leave the facility and premises immediately after their session ends.
7. Please come dressed as much as possible. Locker rooms will be available to finish dressing and storing of bags. Please leave locker rooms immediately after being dressed.
8. Once dressed, please wait out in staging areas for each rink.
9. Restrooms by locker rooms will be limited to 1 person at a time. They should not be used as a changing area.
10. There will be 15 minutes between ice times.
11. No bags or personnel items can be left in the bathrooms or hallways.
12. No dryland activities will be allowed inside.
13. Any skater that begins to COVID 19 symptoms needs to be removed from the rink immediately and sent home.
14. Drinking fountains and are unavailable. Bring your own water bottle.
15. Must follow social distancing guidelines.
16. **FACEMASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES UNLESS ON THE ICE!**

Facility Policies & Procedures Phase 3:

1. Each skater will be allowed two spectators inside arena.
2. No skating groups larger than 2 pods (25 skaters each).
3. Four Seasons Centre staff will take the MDH screening daily, before their shift, and use appropriate PPE.
4. Any water bottles left in the arena will be thrown away each night.
5. All Four Seasons Centre staff have been trained in cleaning for COVID-19.
6. Hand sanitizer stations will be located in designated areas in the East Arena and West Arena. We will keep these filled as supplies allow. This isn't a substitute for handwashing.
7. Bathrooms will be cleaned as much as possible while the rink is in use.
8. All frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned between groups when possible and at the end of the night.
